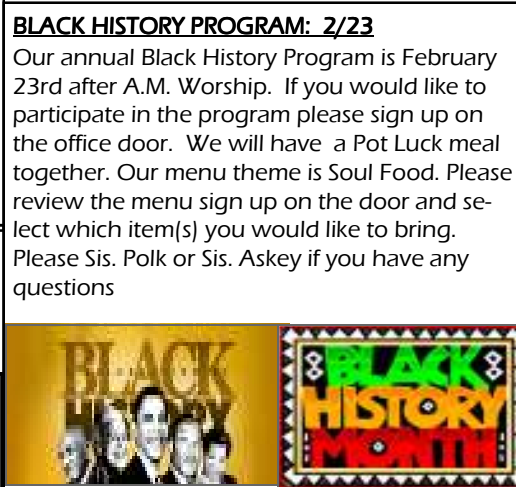


CVCC-Mission Statement
